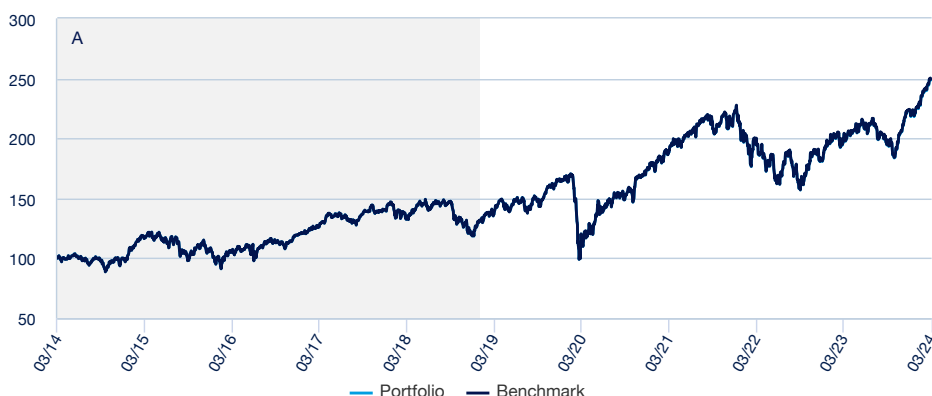

They represent the largest European companies in each of the 18 Supersectors as defined by the ICB classification (Industry Classification Benchmark). 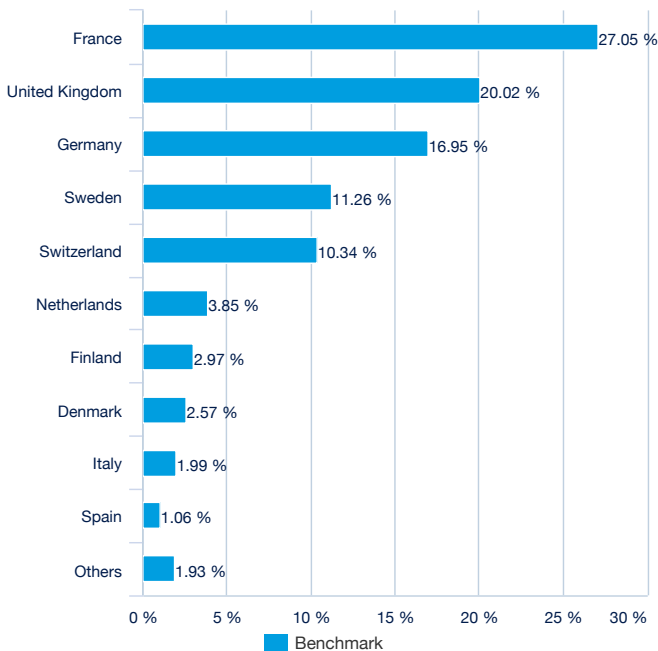

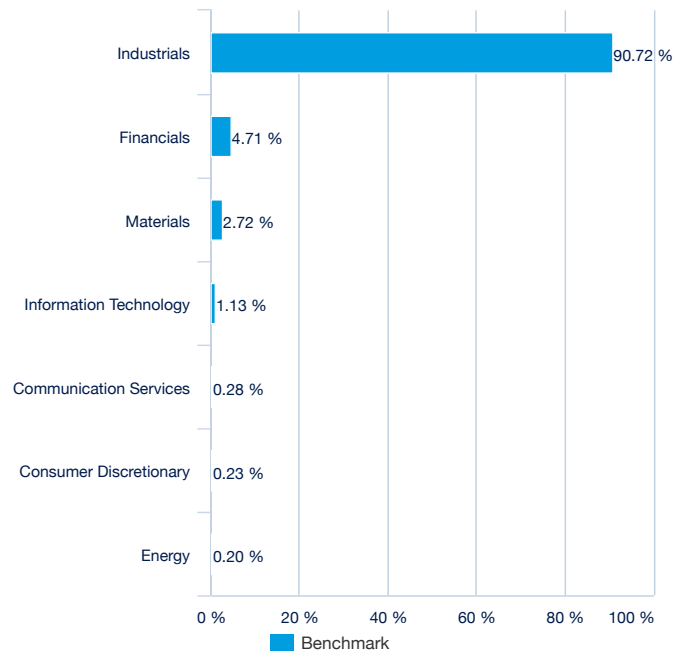
